


## You will need:

- .Wood Glue
- .Craft Knife
- .Sandpaper


## How To Build: Painting Lap Station

Always test fit pieces before applying any glue. Lightly sand the places where you wish to apply glue, this helps to create a stronger bond between the two surfaces. Always use a strong wood glue, craft pva glue is not recommended.


1: Carefully remove all the pieces from the sprue, making sure to be extra careful on the smaller pieces. We advise cutting the tabs with a sharp craft knife on the smaller, more delicate pieces.




2. Take one of the base pieces, and the 4 longest support pieces, and glue them in place as shown, making sure that the slots are facing up




3. Glue the 2 small support pieces in place as shown, making sure the slots are facing up



4. Next, take the remaining 4 long support pieces, and glue them in place as shown. Make sure that they are slotted all the way down, and sit level with the existing pieces




5. Now, take the remaining 3 shorter support pieces, and glue them in place as shown. Make sure that they are slotted all the way down, and sit level with the existing pieces




6. Next, take the second base piece, and glue it down onto all of the support pieces you just glued in place. Make sure to press it down all the way so that there are no gaps between the supports and the base pieces.


Make sure to clean any glue out from the drawer slot



7. Now glue and assemble the paint rack




8. Now glue the shelf support, shelf, and one of the side panel pieces in place. Glueing the side panel on first will make it easier to attach the shelf and support pieces. Make sure to remove any excess glue from the drawer slots




9. Now attach the paint rack to the shelf and side panel as shown using the slots and tabs, then glue the final side panel in place.

Make sure to remove any excess glue from the drawer slots




10. Now glue the back piece in place



11. Now build the drawers, all 3 drawers are built the same way, but only one has the dividers.

Follow these next steps for all 3 drawers



then add the short divider piece (if applicable) This Way Up 13. Glue the second long side to the base, then add the long divider piece (if applicable) This Way Up 14. Now glue on the two short sides, and add the handles 15. Slide the finished drawers into place, your Lap Station is now complete!
