


How To Build: Paint Rack

Always test fit pieces before applying any glue. Lightly sand the places where you wish to apply glue, this helps to create a stronger bond between the two surfaces. Always use a strong wood glue, craft pva glue is not recommended.


1: Carefully remove all the pieces from the sprue, making sure to be extra careful on the smaller pieces. We advise cutting the tabs with a sharp craft knife on the smaller, more delicate pieces.




2: First assemble the 5 large shelves. Make sure the support rails glue in from the top of the shelf, and not the bottom




3: Next assemble the small top shelf. Make sure the support rail glues in from the bottom of the shelf, and not the top




4: Now assemble the bottom support. Make sure the support rail glues in from the bottom, and not the top



5: Now take all the assembled shelves, and glue them into the side pieces as shown. Make sure to test fit the pieces before glueing to make sure everything goes in the correct places.



6: Next, glue the bottom pieces in place, making sure the piece with the cutouts (shown in red) goes in first.
