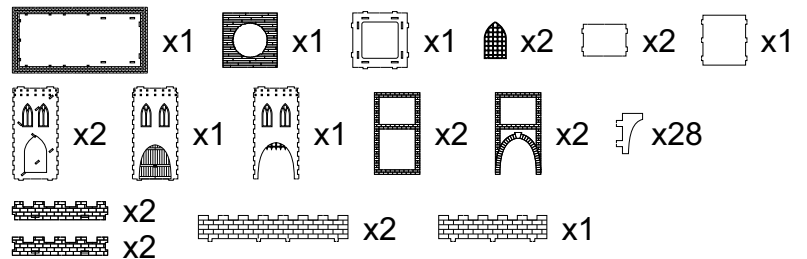
You will need:

- .Wood Glue
- .Craft Knife
- .Sandpaper

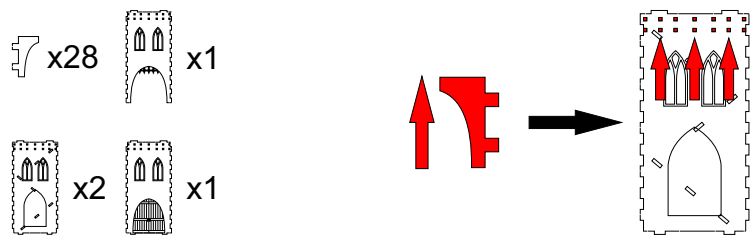
## How To Build: Medieval Theme Dice Tower

Always test fit pieces before applying any glue. Lightly sand the places where you wish to apply glue, this helps to create a stronger bond between the two surfaces. Always use a strong wood glue, craft pva glue is not recommended.

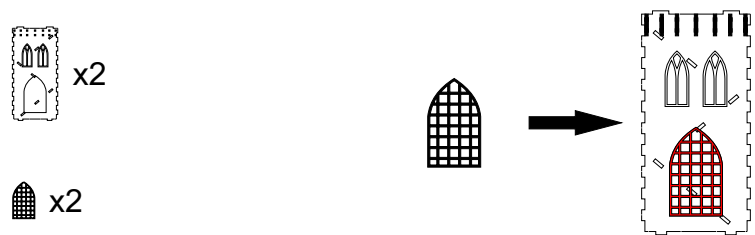
1: Carefully remove all the pieces from the sprue, making sure to be extra careful on the smaller pieces. We advise cutting the tabs with a sharp craft knife on the smaller, more delicate pieces.



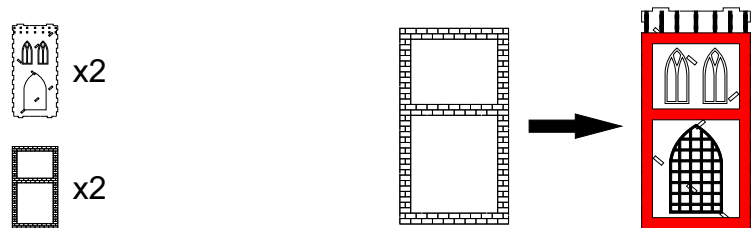
2: Take all four of the wall pieces, and glue all of the curved support pieces in place, making sure they sit tight against the walls. Make sure that the widest part of the support piece is closest to the top of the tower wall as shown



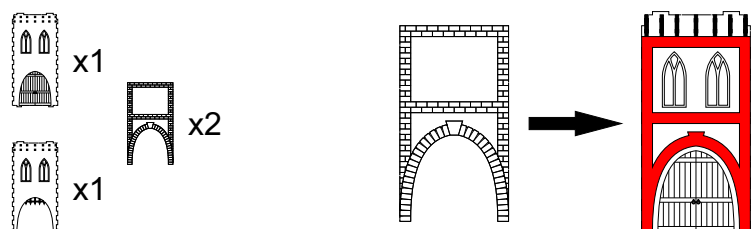
3. Now take the two side walls, and the two arched grates. Glue the grates in place as shown, making sure to clean off any glue that goes into the floor slots. You will see an outline where the grate should be located



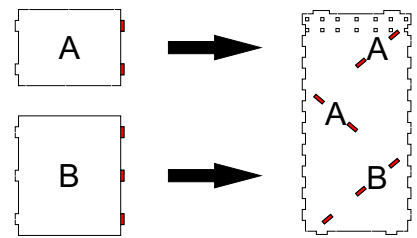
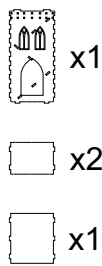
4. Now glue the brick frame pieces into place on both of the side walls, making sure they are pushed up tight against the support pieces, and sit flush on both edges. Make sure to clean off any glue that goes into the corner tabs



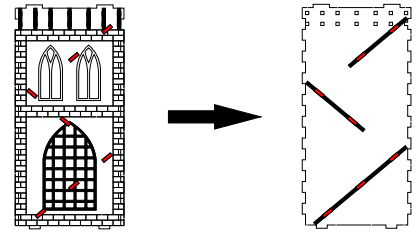
5. Now glue the brick frame pieces into place on both the front and the back walls, making sure they are pushed up tight against the support pieces, and sit flush on both edges. Make sure to clean off any glue that goes into the corner tabs



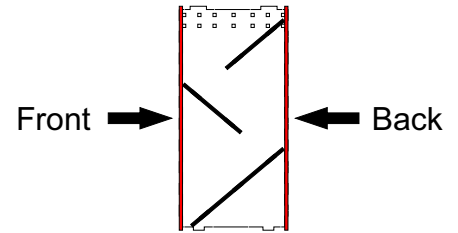
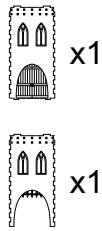
6: Take one of the side pieces, and all three of the floor pieces. Slot the smaller floor pieces (A) into the top two sets of slots, and the larger piece (B) into the lower set of slots as shown.



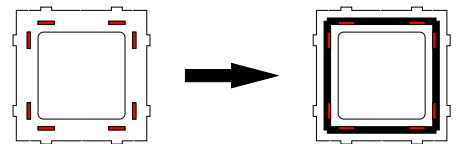
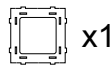
7: Now slot the other side piece into place



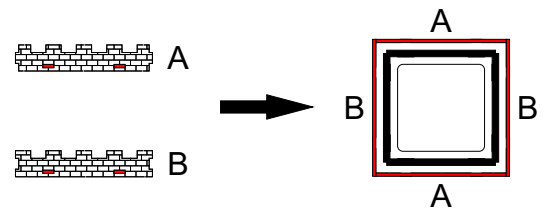
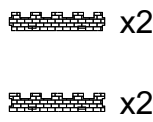
8: Now slot the front and back walls into place, making sure that the bottom floor piece slopes towards the opening



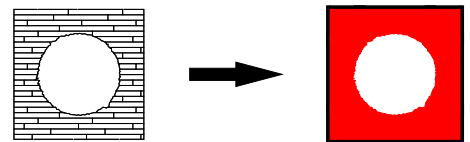
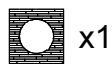
8: Slot the roof piece down onto the tabs on the top of assembled tower.



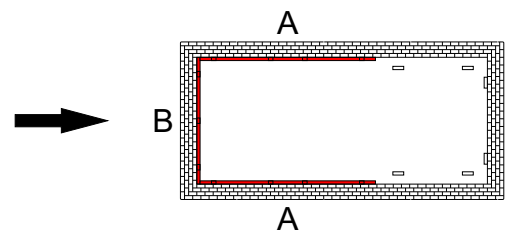
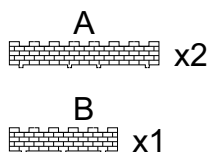
9: Now take the four brick rampart pieces, and slot them onto the tabs on the roof piece as shown



10: Glue the decorative panel in place on top of the roof piece as shown



11: Now take the base, and glue the three wall pieces in place as shown



11: Slot the finished tower onto the base. Your Medieval Theme Dice Tower is now complete
